Entity Form is required. |     | 4.3 of the technical specification requires a 'list of the professional qualifications of the subcontractors' next paragraph 'EBA reserves the right to request at a later stage documentation in relation to the Exclusion and Selection criteria for any proposed contractor' - which seems to suggest that any potential sub-contractors need only be named (with legal status and address) and listed with qualifications. And that the Declaration of Honour and Legal Entity form, may be required at a later date at the wish of the EBA.  Whereas 10.2.2 and 10.3.1 both state 'including any sub-contractor' in relation to the Declaration of Honour and Legal Entity form - which suggest both forms are mandatory. Could you please clarify which is correct?  Furthermore, in the last paragraph of 10.3.1 it states 'sub-contractor(s) shall not be required to fill out or provide documents when the services provided represent less than 20% of the contract value'  - does this mean no forms if a sub-contractor is providing less than 20% individually, or if sub-contractors collectively are less than 20% e.g. what is required of say 3 sub-contractors | Declaration of Honour  As stated in Section 10.2.2 each tenderer including any sub-contractor must provide a Declaration of Honour.  Legal Entity Form  As stated in Section 10.3.1 each sub-contractor is required to submit a Legal Entity Form unless the services provided represent less than 20% of the contract value.  Therefore if a sub-contractor is providing less than 20% of the contract value individually no Legal Entity Form is required.  Equally if sub-contractors are providing less than 20% of the contract value collectively no Legal Entity Form is required.  Furthermore if three (3) sub-contractors each provide 10% of the contract value i.e. 30% of the |
