Professor Laura Nieri is a Full Professor of Banking and Finance at the University of Genoa, where she also directs the Social Sciences curriculum at Ianua Superior School. With over two decades of academic experience, she has held teaching and leadership positions at several prestigious institutions, including the Catholic University of Milan and the University of Chieti-Pescara. She has taught a wide range of courses at the Bachelor's, Master's, and PhD levels, with a focus on financial systems, corporate finance, and risk management.

Her research interests center on the banking sector, particularly in areas such as credit risk, regulation, and the impact of Fintech on financial stability. She has published extensively in top academic journals and has contributed to research on emerging risks like climate risk and sustainability in finance. Over the years, she has participated in numerous research projects, securing competitive grants and contributing to influential platforms.

In addition to her academic work, Professor Nieri brings substantial expertise from the banking and financial services sectors.
