Maria is Head of the Regulatory Analysis Unit at ABI, the Italian Banking Association.

Maria graduated in Economics at LUISS Guido Carli University in Rome. After a short experience in the Italian Stock Exchange, she joined ABI in 2002.

Here, she spent the first years in the Impact Assessment Unit, where she had the opportunity to study various fields of banking and financial regulations (ranging from financial markets to fiscal policies).

In the following years, she joined the Economic Research Unit, where her work was mainly focused on issues related to the area of banking prudential regulatory framework and supervision. Her activities included carrying out analyses and steering the activity of relevant ABI interbank working groups, to inform dialogue with authorities, as well as taking part in international industry bodies.

In November 2022, Maria was appointed Head of the Regulatory Analysis Unit, within the ABI Research and Regulation Division. Among the main topics addressed by the Unit are banking prudential regulation and banking statistical reporting.

Her long experience in ABI allowed her to thoroughly study many fields of banking and financial regulation - and notably of the prudential framework – not only having regard to their objectives and contents, but also with the aim of assessing their economic impacts and addressing their implementing and operational challenges (also thanks to continuous dialogue with banks' experts).
