		EBA website, emails or other forms. All information provided by respondents is accessible by a limited number of EBA staff and the provider of support and maintenance services for the EBA website. Certain consultations and discussions are published by the EBA. The specific details on the publication of the results are provided in the		
		specific data protection notice. The EBA may contact the respondents via email to request clarification or to verify that the responses come from the organisation the respondent listed in their reply.

The personal information collected will not be communicated to third parties. Certain responses provided as part of certain projects will be published on the EBA's website, unless requested otherwise in the consultation form by indicating that the response is confidential. More specific information related to particular surveys will be provided in the specific data protection notices. The personal data will be processed by the EBA within the EU/EEA.

14	General description of security measures, where possible	Security measures are implemented to ensure integrity, confidentiality and availability of information. The EBA has put appropriate technical and organisational measures in place to protect personal data from accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorised disclosure of, or access to personal data. Personal data of contributors are recorded in the EBA's database, which is accessible with ID and password and only to relevant staff members on a "need-to-know" basis. The default provisions include backups, centralized logging, software updates and continuous vulnerability assessment and follow-up.
