Hired at the Bank of Italy in 1996, I have been dealing with a wide set of issues in banking supervision: direct supervision of banks, financial regulation, international standards, financial stability, regulatory impact assessment, international policy and cooperation. After 3 years as a supervisor in the Treviso branch and a 10 years experience as an economist in the Research Unit of the Financial and Banking Supervision Dept, in 2008 I was appointed Head of the Regulatory Impact Assessment Unit; in this role I had the opportunity to actively contribute to the post-crisis work that led to the Basel III global reform. From 2014 to 2020 I was Head of the SSM Coordination Division, contributing to start-up the SSM coordination function and supporting, as accompanying person, the Bank of Italy representative in the SSM Supervisory Board.

I joined back the Regulation and Macroprudential Analysis Directorate in 2020 as a Deputy Head and, in 2022, I was appointed Head of the same Directorate. The Directorate (100 headcounts) is responsible for carrying out horizontal activities such as coordinating the contribution to the major regulatory and supervisory fora, contributing to national legislation in banking and finance, performing stress tests and macroprudential analysis, following-up on accounting and reporting activities and providing advice to the Directorates in charge of vertical supervision of banks and other financial intermediaries. I am currently Alternate in the EBA Board of Supervisors; I was previously member of several committees and working groups, such as the Financial Stability Committee (ECB), Advisory Technical Committee (ESRB), Senior Management Network, HLG on SREP and Simplification Group (SSM), Policy Development Group, Loss Given Default Group, Capital Monitoring Group and QIS Group (BCBS), Internal Ratings Working Group (EU Commission), Supplementary Measures Group, Operational Networks, Pillar 2 Network and Joint Group on Validation (CEBS).
