

# Invitation to the EBA introductory training on AML/CFT

15 February 2021, European Banking Authority

## Background

Money laundering and terrorist financing (ML/TF) harm society in a number of ways. ML/TF undermines the trust of citizens in financial institutions, negatively affects market integrity and threatens the stability of the financial system.

The anti-money laundering and counter terrorist financing (AML/CFT) regulatory framework is rapidly evolving. For example, the European legislature recently gave the EBA new powers to lead, coordinate and monitor EU supervisors' fight against ML/TF. It also gave EBA a new objective, to prevent the use of the financial system for the purposes of money laundering and terrorist financing. Moreover, many authorities are enhancing their approaches and in some instances expanding their resources.

#### Objective

Aimed at supervisors that are new to AML/CFT, this training will provide a high-level overview of the key concepts used in AML/CFT supervision, the AML/CFT legislative framework, the relevant standard-setters and public actors and how these interact. Furthermore, an overview of the key EU AML/CFT requirements for financial institutions and their supervisors will be provided. The training focuses on the financial sector.

#### Target group

This training is targeted at staff in supervisory authorities from across the EU interested in obtaining a basic understanding of AML/CFT for the financial services sector. No previous AML/CFT experience is necessary.

Staff from competent authorities that are not members of the EBA's Board of Supervisors are also welcome to register.
