José Rosas is Deputy Head of the Financial Stability Department in Banco de Portugal since 2017. His areas of responsibility cover financial stability and prudential regulatory policy of credit institutions.

He had been previously Head of the Macroprudential Policy and Regulation Division in the Financial Stability Department after having worked in the Banking Prudential Supervision Department as Head of Division responsible for the banking policy advice, internal model validation, financial and prudential assessment of the banking system.

Currently, he is member of the Standing Committee on Regulation and Policy (SCRePol) and is nominated as alternate of the Portuguese member of the of Board of Supervisors of the EBA. In the past, he has been member of the Supervisory Policies Network of the ECB/SSM and member of the European Enforcers Coordination Sessions (EECS) which operates under the oversight of ESMA.

José Rosas joined Banco de Portugal in 1993 and has a degree in Management from ISEG - Lisbon School of Economics and Management.
