Since 11 February 2016, Mr Pēters Putniņš has been the Chairman of Financial and Capital Market Commission (FCMC).

Pēters Putniņš was born on 23 September 1973. Pēters Putniņš holds a Master's degree in Law from the University of Latvia (2010) and a Bachelor's degree in International Relations from the University of Latvia (1996).

Previous professional experience has been closely related to the financial sector. From 2005 to 2012, Pēters Putniņš had been a consultant on legal matters at the Bank of Latvia; since 2005, Attorney-at-Law, and from 2002 to 2004, Head of Legal Department at the Bank of Latvia. From 2001 to 2002, Pēters Putniņš had been Vice President of joint stock company Reģionālā Investīciju Banka. He had been employed also with insurance joint stock companies Balta and Rīgas Fenikss, as well as with "Spāde un Miķelsons Law Office". On 20 December 2012, he was appointed as Deputy Chairman of the FCMC.
