

Mateusz Mokrogulski graduated from Warsaw School of Economics in 2002, where in 2010 he obtained a PhD in economics. He still continues his academic activity at Warsaw School of Economics as a lecturer of microeconomics and managerial economics.

In 2003 he started his professional career at the BGZ Bank (currently BGZ BNP Paribas) as a macroeconomic analyst. In 2009 he joined the KNF – Polish Financial Supervision Authority, where he initially worked in the Research Department. He was involved in a wide variety of tasks at the EBA and ESRB level, including EBA Stress Testing Task Force, ATC Task Force on Stress Testing, Joint Committee Risk Sub-Committee and O-SII Work Streams within the EBA Peer Review.

In September 2017 he was appointed Acting Director of the Commercial Banking Department at the KNF. He has been a Director of that Department since March 2018. His current activities include off-site supervision of commercial banks, analyses of the domestic banking sector, participation in the Financial Stability Committee meetings, co-ordination of the EBA stress test process, as well as co-operation with the ECB and other consolidating supervisors within supervisory colleges.
