Adelaide Cavaleiro has a degree in Economics from the Universidade Católica de Lisboa and joined the Banco de Portugal in October 1985, as an economist in the Foreign Department. She is currently Head of the Financial Stability Department, after having been Deputy Head of the Banking Prudential Supervision Department and prior to this Chief of Division responsible for the banking policy advice, internal model validation, financial and prudential assessment of the banking system and coordination of international activities in the field of prudential regulation and supervision.

Adelaide Cavaleiro is a member, of the Advisory Technical Committee of the ESRB, of the Financial Stability Committee (ESCB) and of the European Banking Authority (Board of Supervisors – alternate). She has in the past been a member of several international groups like the European Banking Committee (EBC) the Financial Action Task Force (FATF), Committee on Financial Markets (OECD) and CEBS. She also participated actively in Working Groups of the EU Council (e.g. for the discussion of directives, such as the CRD).
